

Travel by air with Skybus

Take a shortcut to Scilly . . . With flights from Southampton, Bristol, Exeter, Newquay and Land's End. When you choose Skybus you can be sure that whichever departure point you choose, you will shorten your journey time to the Isles of Scilly, and as you approach the islands your first dramatic glimpse of the Scillonian archipelago will take your breath away, as their remote beauty unfolds below.

HOW EASY IS IT . . . All airports have flights operating 6 days a week, Monday to Saturday. Access to our regional departure points is easy with the rail and road links.

SOUTHAMPTON is easy to get to with a direct train link to Southampton Parkway (at the airport) which operates from Waterloo. South West Trains and Virgin trains run extensive services from the station. By car the airport is less than a mile from junction 5 of the M27, only 4 miles from Southampton, 20 from Portsmouth and 9 from Winchester. The M3 is just 1 mile from the airport, offering easy access from Basingstoke, London, and via the A33/A34 from Oxford and the Midlands.

BRISTOL INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT is situated on the A38, eight miles from the city of Bristol. Air Southwest operate a limited service from Manchester to Bristol.

Arriving by car, From South M5, junction 22 and follow signs for airport. From North M5 junction 18. From South Wales follow M4 to junction 22 and new M49 to join M5 at junction 13A. From East M4, junction 20 join M5 southbound to junction 13. From South-East, follow A4 towards Bristol, then left into A4174 then follow signs for airport.

EXETER is easy to reach and is straight off the A30, follow the M5 southbound and follow the signs for the airport. The airport, which is situated five miles from Exeter city centre and one and a half miles from the M5 motorway, is served by a bus service, with links to rail services.

Service 56 (56A 60B): Exeter St. Davids Station - Bus Station - Airport - Exmouth. Not Sundays or Bank Holidays

Service 379 : Exeter St. Davids Station - Bus Station - Airport - Sidmouth. Sundays and Bank Holidays.



NEWQUAY - This is the first departure point in Cornwall when travelling from up country, and is easy to get to from the A30. From the East: Follow the A30 through Bodmin towards Newquay until you are sign posted to Indian Queens and the Airport. Turn off the A30 and follow all signs. From the West: Follow the A30 East leaving the main town of Newquay on your left. Take the turning signposted Wadebridge and Indian Queens and follow signs to the Airport. With flights also arriving at Newquay from London Gatwick (Air Southwest) and Stansted (Ryanair) this is a small and friendly airport with great air links.

Cornwall County Council have introduced a £5 per person airport development fee which is payable at Newquay airport.

LAND'S END offers flights every 10-15 minutes during the main season. Follow the A30 to Penzance, then signs for Lands End and then the Airport.

Skybus will then service reduced schedules for Land's End and Newquay until February 2011.

Approx flight duration:
Southampton to St Marys 90 minutes
Bristol to St Marys 75 minutes
Exeter to St Marys 60 minutes
Newquay to St Marys 30 minutes
Land's End to St Marys 15 minutes

Skybus operate 3 Britten Norman "Islander" 8-seater aircraft from Land's End, and 3 DHC-6 De Havilland "Twin Otter" 19-seater aircraft from the other airports. Skybus reserve the right to substitute another aircraft if necessary.

CHECK IN TIMES

Passengers are requested to check in one hour prior to departure at Southampton, Bristol, Exeter, Newquay and 45 minutes prior to departure from Land's End. Some form of photographic identity is now required.

CAR PARKING

If you need parking at Land's End, or a transfer from the railway station at Bristol Temple Meads, Exeter St David's or Penzance please confirm at the time of booking.

LUGGAGE ALLOWANCES

Skybus passengers are reminded that up to 15 kgs of personal luggage per passenger are allowed free of charge. For those using a joint allowance, the maximum weight per luggage item is 20kgs. St Mary's Airport will not accept single items of luggage exceeding 20kg (44lbs). Excess baggage is accepted on a space available basis only and is subject to a charge of £3 per kilo. Any excess luggage which cannot be carried on your scheduled aircraft will be off-loaded and will follow to your destination airport, where space allows, on the next available flight. Please note excess baggage accepted on your outward journey will not automatically be accepted on your return journey.

CANCELLED OR DELAYED FLIGHTS

Every effort is made to operate at the times entered on the ticket, however, the carrier is not liable for additional costs, loss or damage incurred by passengers resulting from delayed or cancelled flights.

If it is not possible to operate flights, passengers will be offered alternative transport if available (by road and/or sea) to the destination shown on the ticket, or to remain at the airport for a flight with seats to become available. These may not necessarily be on the same day.

Skybus is not responsible for any additional costs incurred by passengers in such circumstances and no refunds will be given.
