

TORNADO HITS SCILLY



With an outrageous 450 horsepower delivered by its twin 225 HP outboard engines, the Tornado is built for speed. Acquired by Bryher Boat Services in March 2007, the Tornado offers a thrilling, white knuckle opportunity to see the islands. Travelling at up to fifty knots and carrying 12 passengers, the Tornado is simply the most exciting way to get around Scilly.

A tight grip and the desire to move very fast through the water (and sometimes through the air) is the key to enjoying this magnificent craft. Under the skilful command of one of the expert Bryher boatmen, the Tornado will fly through the waves, dart between rocks and turn on a sixpence. The exhilaration of leaping over the waves makes for an adrenalin filled alternative to the more sedate boat trips usually on offer around Scilly.

A ride on the Tornado is not only about speed. The Tornado can be as stealthy as it can be swift. The forty-five minute special excursion run by Bryher Boats also includes the chance to get close to local wildlife such as seals and puffins. The high manoeuvrability of the Tornado allows the boat and its passengers to approach rocks, birds and mammals safely and quietly. The knowledgeable boatman at the helm provides fascinating information about the islands, their history and fauna.

For a sensational whistle-stop tour of Scilly, that is both fascinating and breathtaking, you can do no better than to take a trip on the Tornado. ■
